

Conditions:

3. Dock stay requests must be submitted via email to: **chernandez@fuerteamador.com** and/or **service@fuerteamador.com**
4. Dock reservations are subject to space availability. Our visitor dock offer is limited and managed according to a reservation schedule.
5. Approval of a dock stay request will be accompanied by a **quotation** for the dock services.
6. To process a dock stay request, we require the following information:

Owner's or Captain's name

Yacht name

LOA

Beam

Draft

ETA

ETD

7. Dock stays must be prepaid upon check-in.
8. Check-out time is 11:00 a.m.
9. A copy of the yacht's registration and valid insurance policy is **mandatory**.
10. **No refunds** will be issued for early departures.
11. A **credit card (VISA or MasterCard only; AMEX not accepted)** must be provided to cover recurring charges such as dockage, electricity consumption, ice, fuel, etc.
12. **Dock rental rates include** water and garbage collection services.
13. **Electricity consumption** must be paid upon check-out. We do **not provide adapters** for pedestal connections.

Current electricity rate: **\$0.25 per kWh**

Available power:

232V – 2x50 AMP, 60 Hz single-phase

480V – 2x100 AMP, 60 Hz three-phase

14. **ETA/ETD confirmation** is required in advance.
15. **Dock assignments** depend on available space at the time of your arrival.
16. From the Marina Regulations:

Right of Admission: (16) Noise must be kept under control. The use of machinery, generators, radios, or televisions by owners, employees, visitors, or agents must not disturb others.

(18) The vessel owner acknowledges that the Marina fosters a **family-friendly environment**, and is therefore responsible for ensuring that guests, captains, crew, and contractors behave respectfully at all times. Intoxicated, immoral, aggressive, threatening, or abusive behavior is **unacceptable** within the Marina premises.

All Fuerte Amador and Flamenco Marina staff must be treated with respect, and any instructions given by Marina or Security personnel must be followed immediately.

Safety: (5) The following activities are **not permitted** on the docks:

(d) Outboard engine maintenance, corrective (overhaul) work on main engines or generators, welding, propeller removal, anode replacement, sanding and painting, solvent use, filter washing or cleaning, or grinding work.

(e) Storing fuel tanks or other containers with fuel or lubricants on the docks.

Refusal to remove them grants the Marina the right to notify the **Port Captain's Office (AMP)** and **ACP authorities** about the imminent contamination risk so they may take appropriate action and apply additional sanctions as per **Flamenco Marina** regulations.
